Today's Service

Today, Jemma Bainton will assume the religious, spiritual, and ethical responsibilities that come with being a Jewish adult by becoming a *Bat Mitzvah*. The term refers to someone who is obligated to follow the commandments as an adult. The first time someone leads the community as an adult is an important and significant Jewish life cycle event. By leading this service, Jemma marks a significant milestone in her life and affirms what we hope will be a lifelong commitment to Jewish living and learning.

Digital Decorum

Digital Decorum

Wearing a prayer shawl: In our synagogue, the *tallit* (prayer shawl) may be worn by all adult Jews, regardless of gender. The braided fringes at the four corners of the tallit remind the wearer to observe the commandments of Judaism.

Wearing a head covering: A *kippah* (a head covering also called a *yarmulke* in Yiddish) is traditionally worn by everyone during the service. Unlike the *tallit*, which is an article of clothing reserved for adult Jews, wearing some sort of head covering is an act of respect available to anyone entering a synagogue. A head covering announces the wearer's acknowledgement that there is a Holy Presence above. At home you are encouraged to use any head covering you have available.

About Shabbat Morning Services

The Shabbat Morning Service consists of blessings, psalms, and prayers of praise and gratitude to God. It is the central moment of worship on the Jewish sabbath, which runs from Friday evening at sundown until Saturday evening after sundown. The morning service includes some of Judaism's most significant prayers. The Shema, which expresses Judaism's belief in the oneness of God, is the oldest fixed daily prayer in Judaism. It follows the Barchu, the communal call to prayer. We then pray the Amidah, a series of prayers said while standing and facing east.

About Shabbat Morning Services The Torah Service

The public reading from the Torah is the central part of our morning worship. The Torah is divided into 54 *parshiyot* (portions), one of which is read each week. (We double up portions a few times a year.) The weekly *parasha* is divided into sections chanted by Torah readers, and this morning by Jemma. Each Torah reader must chant the section accurately without relying on vowels, punctuation, musical notation, or separation of paragraphs, as none are included in the Torah scroll. Before each section, a person or persons will be called by their Hebrew names for the honor of an *aliyah* (going up) to recite the blessings before and after reading.

About Shabbat Morning Services The Torah Service

The centerpiece of today's celebration will be when Jemma has her first *aliyah*, an honor expressly reserved for adults. This morning is the first time she will be permitted to go up to the *bimah* (pulpit) and recite the blessings over the Torah on behalf of the congregation.

Jemma will then speak about the meaning of this week's *parasha* by offering a self-composed *D'var Torah* (words of Torah).
